

ACTC SCHOLARSHIPS

Local and state scholarships are available to help new and continuing students with college expenses.

Applicants are typically selected on the basis of achievement /merit and financial need demonstrated by the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Some scholarships have additional requirements, such as residency or area of study. The John T. Smith Scholarship requires a separate application in addition to the FAFSA.

AMERICAN LEGION POST 76 JACK FUGEMAN & AMERICAN LEGION POST 76 BUILDING CORPORATION SCHOLARSHIPS

Awarded to students enrolled in the Associate Degree Nursing Program who demonstrate potential for academic success, maintain at least a 2.75 GPA and require financial assistance. Preference will be given to military veterans and/or their family members.

AGNES BURNETTE JOHNSON SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Awarded to a Boyd County High School graduate who demonstrates potential for academic excellence and a need for financial assistance.

AMY DENISE BRUNER MEMORIAL DISABLED STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

Awarded to a sophomore who has demonstrated potential for academic success, including a 3.0 GPA, has a permanent physical disability (preferably neurological in nature), is pursuing a degree in medical field (including counseling and psychology), is focused and has clear education goals and a strong work ethic.

ALLEN D. & PATRICIA C. CLINE SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Awarded to full time students in good standing who are actively involved in ACTC's Theatre studies. Students who maintain full time status with a 3.0 or better GPA and remain active in the theatre program can be considered for re-award.

ANNE KOUNS STUDENT AID FUND

Awarded to students demonstrating financial need and potential for academic success.

ASHLAND KIWANIS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Awarded to a Paul Blazer High School or Rose Hill Christian School graduate demonstrating a commitment to civic activities. A second scholarship will be awarded to a nontraditional student.

BARBARA SEIBERT STUDENT AID FUND

Awarded to students demonstrating financial need and potential for academic success.

BIG SANDY SUPERSTORE SCHOLARSHIP

Awarded to part-time or full-time undergraduate students who are either full-time active employees or children of full-time active employees of Big Sandy Superstores.

BOB & PAT GOODPASTER SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Awarded to non-traditional students who have children, demonstrate potential for academic success and are enrolled in a minimum of 6 credit hours per semester.

CHELLGREN-ASHLAND COMMUNITY & TECHNICAL COLLEGE FUND

First preference is given to current or former residents of the Ramey-Estep Home of Boyd County who demonstrate financial need and potential for academic success.

COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY

COMMONWEALTH SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Awarded to recent high school valedictorians, salutatorians or top 10% of graduating class. Renewable for one year.

DAVID N. MICHALAK MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Awarded to students with a GPA of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale who have completed a minimum of 24 semester hours at ACTC.

EDWARD L. BUCHANAN ENDOWMENT FUND

Awarded to students enrolled in the nursing program who demonstrate satisfactory academic progress.

FIFTH THIRD BANK SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Award available to a student who indicates interest in a banking or business career.

FYFFE JONES GROUP ACCOUNTING AWARD

Awarded to a full-time student who has completed the first year of accounting studies and has demonstrated academic success.

GALLOWAY TRUST SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Awarded to students who attended high school in Boyd County or Greenup County KY who have a minimum GPA of 3.3 on and demonstrate the potential to pursue a baccalaureate degree program at a college or university in Kentucky.

GOLDIE M. WILSON SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Awarded to a student demonstrating potential for academic success.

GRIFFITH DELANEY & HILLMAN & COMPANY SCHOLARSHIP

Awarded to a students who demonstrates potential for academic success. First preference will go to students who have indicated an interest in an accounting career.

HARRY C. FERGUSON, II MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Awarded to a resident of Kentucky who demonstrates financial need and the potential for academic success including a 2.5 GPA from either high school or ACTC.

HERB AND ALENE BOGGS ALBAN SCHOLARSHIP

Awarded to a student demonstrating potential for academic success and an interest in a business career.

JOHN T. SMITH MINORITY SCHOLARSHIP:

Awarded to recognize outstanding African-American residents of Kentucky. Grade point average, rank in class, ACT scores and extra-curricular activities are considered.

JOSEPH AND SYLVIA MANSBACH SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Awarded to students who demonstrate potential for academic success, show financial need and/or work at least 10 hours a week during the academic term(s) and demonstrate academic progress toward their educational goals.

KAPLAN & SIMONS SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Awarded to non-traditional students who demonstrate potential for academic success, require financial assistance and enroll at least six credit hours per semester. Recipients must maintain a minimum 2.75 GPA based on a 4.0 scale.

KCTCS PRESIDENT'S SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Awarded to graduates of Kentucky high schools according to ACTC Scholarship guidelines.

KENTUCKY COLONELS BETTER LIFE SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Awarded to a non-traditional student from KY who is a single working parent with one or more children under age 12 and who demonstrates enthusiasm for learning, potential for academic success and a need for financial assistance.

KENTUCKY POWER SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Awarded to a non-traditional student who demonstrates need and academic excellence. Recipient must be from Kentucky and a full-time, degree-seeking student.

LOU EASTHAM SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Awarded to a Boyd County High School graduate who demonstrates potential for academic excellence and a need for financial assistance.

LYSBETH BARNETT SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Awarded to outstanding student majoring in business management with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better based on a 4.0 system.

ROBERT B. HILTON EDUCATION TRUST

Awarded to a Paul G. Blazer High School graduate who has resided in Boyd County for at least three years, is enrolled in a Transfer Curriculum and demonstrates financial need.

RUIE KENNARD KELLEY ENDOWMENT SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Awarded to a student demonstrating potential for academic success.

SCHOLARSHIP & TALENT GRANT ENDOWMENT

Awarded to deserving full-time or part-time students include scholarship, talent grants and emergency loans.

THEODORE C. & BENNIE J. SHIELDS SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Awarded to a graduate of Boyd County High School who demonstrates potential for academic success, requires financial assistance and maintains a minimum GPA of 3.0. At least 50% of the scholarships granted must be to female recipients.

TROY B. & SOPHIA WHEELER MEMORIAL TRUST ENDOWMENT FUND

Awarded to students from Northeastern Kentucky who are enrolled in health science programs including but not limited to Associate Degree Nursing, Licensed Practical Nursing, Surgical Technology, Pharmacy Technology, etc.

YWCA SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Awarded to female Boyd or Greenup County residents who are deserving and need financial aid. Recipient shall maintain at least a B average and also must apply for Pell funding.
